February is known as the month of love. It is easy on Valentine's Day to give flowers, a card, candy, or a gift to your spouse, children, family members, and maybe even a close friend. But why is it that many of us need this holiday to be able to tell someone how we feel? God loves us beyond measure – He was willing to give the life of His perfect Son so that we might have eternal life with Him. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16 When questioned by the Pharisees, "which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself." Matt. 22:36-39 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another. John 13:34-35 "We love because God loved us first." 1 John 4:19 (This is our "remember verse" in Lil' K right now!) So, as Christians, we are commanded to love!
